The NHS does not cover every type of service.

The practice provides a number of services outside of the NHS for which there is a charge such as medical examinations or reports and also for specific vaccinations or immunisations.

A list of some of the services for which we charge and their prices can be found here.

Prior to your appointment for the following vaccinations, we will require a 50% non-refundable deposit.

Immunisation / Vaccination	£ Per Dose
Hepatitis A Vaccine (chargeable if for Northern Europe, New Zealand, Australia – free for everywhere else)	£46
Hepatitis B Vaccine (chargeable if you require it for travel purposes / for occupational purposes, your employer will need to make a request in writing – free for treatment of conditions)	£46
Typhoid (chargeable if for Northern Europe, New Zealand, Australia – free for everywhere else)	£40
Yellow Fever	£70
ACWY Meningococcal Vaccine	£55
